Fellowship development session

- HRP is looking for people to go on-line to fill out the volunteer form. We need volunteers for Bridging -the- Gap and for the World Convention in Orlando (2018). The World Convention organizers need about 2000 volunteers to staff this event. You can volunteer on the naflorida.org website.
- Discussion about youth out reach programs put on by PR. In one area the H&I were bringing meetings to a youth facility. This is really PR's responsibility to introduce the youth to Narcotics Anonymous with a PR presentation. It was suggested that the younger members of NA should go into these facilities because the youth could better identify with them.
- Fellowship Development has a different meanings to all areas in our region. It is also called collaborative subcommittee. It can be what ever works for your area.
- Some areas have members who don't attend areas because they meet in clubhouses, churches and facilities devoted to other affiliations. Discussion on this topic included:
 1. Find a city facility- they are reasonably priced and most cities have them.
 2. The body as a whole needs to decide by a majority vote.
- The 2017 Florida Region Service Symposium will be held somewhere in central Florida. The committee will meet next month to plan this event.
- Do we want to make the FSS a southeast zonal event or do we want to keep it as it is. RD's in our southeast zone are discussing this possibility to their regions. There was discussion about the pros and cons of each scenarios. Discussion included:
 1. The cost would be too great for an addict to spend to travel these distances.
 2. If the regions share costs to put this event on, it frees up money to help with the cost of travel. GSR's should take this back to groups for discussion. What does the groups want to do?
- Bridging-the-gap forms were shown and there was discussion about content and grammar.

The Future of Zones

- Zones have been a discussion in NA since 1984. Zones can share information to NAWS at the WSC. A zone is responsible to the regions that it serves. There are six regions in the Southeast Zonal Forum (SEZF). They are: South Florida, Florida, Northeast Florida/Alabama, Georgia, South Carolina and North Carolina. More information can

be collected and assimilated in upcoming CAR (conference agenda report) and CAT (conference agenda tract). Zones can provide mentoring and Training Workshops to all members of the zone through videos or webinars on the SEZF website (www.sezf.org).

- GSR's should ask groups if they are interested in learning more about the SEZF by having presentations or webinars on the topic. This will be appearing on the next CAR. Would they like to be involved in the discussion and voting of this topic on the CAR.

- We will have a workshop on this topic at the next RSC in New Smyrna Beach at the Hampton Inn.
