I did attend the last RSC meeting in Safety Harbor. In order not to burden our secretary with a lengthy RCM report, I will only have her report to you all the 2 regional proposals that need to go back to the groups for a vote. The 2 proposals that the groups need to vote on are as follows...

New Proposals:

Proposal#01-09-15 date 9/18/2015

Proposal: To increase term length for the Administrative Workgroup and Resource Coordinators of the Florida Region. Term increase for the Trusted Servant positions of Facilitator, Treasurer, Secretary and Fellowship Development Leader to 2 years; Resource Coordinators to 2 years; Co-Facilitator, Alternate Treasurer, Alternate Secretary and Fellowship Development Co-Leader to two (2) years. To promote the spirit of rotation only one (1) consecutive term will be permitted per Trusted Servant position.

Intent: The increase of term length of Trusted Servant positions allows continuity and fulfillment of strategic plans of each Trusted Servant as determined during the Florida Region's Strategic Planning Meeting during which time each Trusted Servant's position will prioritize project plans which include long term goals, objectives, and outcomes consistent with Florida Region's Purpose and Vision. Having continuity and accountability for the continued development of each project with direct attention by the assigned regional

trusted servant(s).

Spiritual Impact: As we grow in membership and as a worldwide fellowship, the importance of having services to meet the needs of our members and Areas throughout the Florida Region will grow proportionally. As we grow within the Florida Region, it is the duty and responsibility of Trusted Servants to meet the needs of our members by positioning the Fellowship in the Florida Region to fulfill our fellowship's primary purpose as stated in the 1st Concept, 3rd Concept and 9th Tradition.

This proposal for the increase in term length will allow the continuity and development of services initiated by each Trusted Servant's project. The duties and responsibilities for the proposed position will be added to the Guide to Florida Regional Service. Implementation for the increase in term length shall be immediate upon adoption of this proposal by RCMs. Trusted Servants currently serving in their Trusted Servant role upon adoption of this proposal shall be given the option to continue in their Trusted Servant position or opt out of their Trusted Servant position during the 2016 election cycle with no recourse and full acknowledgement that they have fulfilled their position(s).

Financial Impact: With the increase in term limitations there are no foreseeable financial impact to any Trusted Servant position.

Guide to Florida Regional Service Changes:

- Facilitator: page 16, 10th bullet point – This is a two (2) year commitment.
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- Resource Coordinator: page 39 - Term The term of office for Resource Coordinators will be two (2) years.

Proposal #02-09-15 --9/18/2015

Proposal: To create a helpline within one of three options:

Option 1: Regional helpline for the Florida Region

Option 2: Statewide helpline in conjunction with the South Florida Region

Option 3: Continue business as usual with no helpline

Intent: To have a helpline allowing more PSA and PR activities across areas and possibly regions and to filter calls to ASC helplines increasing call volume.

Spiritual Impact: In order to reach the still suffering addict we could increase our PR efforts at the Regional, Area, and state levels centralized around a single toll free number.

Financial Impact: Between \$30.00 and \$200.00 per month depending on which plan is chosen and whether or not the regions collaborate.

Guide to Florida Region Changes: Will be forthcoming depending on outcome of this proposal. Please see workgroup report for specifics.
